Amending the act of April 6, 1951 (P.L.69, No.20), entitled "An act relating to the rights, obligations and liabilities of landlord and tenant and of parties dealing with them and 3 amending, revising, changing and consolidating the law relating thereto," providing for eviction for unlawful 4 discharge of a firearm in an occupied structure. 6 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 9 Section 1. The act of April 6, 1951 (P.L.69, No.20), known 10 as The Landlord and Tenant Act of 1951, is amended by adding a section to read: 11 12 Section 506-A. Eviction for Unlawful Discharge of a Firearm 13 in an Occupied Structure. -- (a) Conviction of a tenant for 14 unlawful discharge of a firearm in an occupied structure in violation of 18 Pa.C.S. § 2707.1 (relating to discharge of a 15 16 firearm into an occupied structure) in any portion of a single-17 family dwelling, apartment, multiple dwelling premises or tenement building shall be a breach of the condition of the 18

lease and shall be grounds for the removal of a tenant from the

single-family dwelling, apartment, multiple dwelling premises or

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- 1 <u>tenement building.</u>
- 2 (b) Failure to remove any tenant for violation of any of the
- 3 provisions of subsection (a) shall not act as a waiver of the
- 4 <u>landlord's rights with regard to the same or any other tenant</u>
- 5 <u>relating to any subsequent acts.</u>
- 6 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
