AN ACT

1	Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An <
2	act relating to the public school system, including certain
3	provisions applicable as well to private and parochial
4	schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the
5	laws relating thereto," further providing for the Office of
6	Safe Schools.
7	AMENDING THE ACT OF MARCH 10, 1949 (P.L.30, NO.14), ENTITLED "AN <
8	ACT RELATING TO THE PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEM, INCLUDING CERTAIN
9	PROVISIONS APPLICABLE AS WELL TO PRIVATE AND PAROCHIAL
10	SCHOOLS; AMENDING, REVISING, CONSOLIDATING AND CHANGING THE
11	LAWS RELATING THERETO, " IN TERMS AND COURSES OF STUDY,
12	PROVIDING FOR FIREARM SAFETY EDUCATION PROGRAM.
13	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
14	hereby enacts as follows:
15	Section 1. Section 1302 A(b) of the act of March 10, 1949 <
16	(P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, is-
17	amended by adding a paragraph to read:
18	Section 1302 A. Office for Safe Schools. * * *
19	(b) The office shall have the power and duty to implement
20	the following:
21	<u>* * *</u>
22	(1.1) To assist the board of any school entity that may

1	elect to provide firearm safety education programs for students
2	in the elementary school grades. To assist school entities
3	electing to provide firearm safety education programs by
4	establishing curriculum guidelines for a standardized program of
5	firearm safety education for the elementary school grades to
6	promote the protection and safety of children enrolled in public
7	schools. The curriculum guidelines shall incorporate, among
8	other principles of firearm safety, accident prevention and
9	rules upon which the Eddie Eagle Gunsafe Program offered by the
10	National Rifle Association is based. School entities electing to
11	provide firearm safety education shall offer instruction
12	pursuant to the office's curriculum guidelines and shall
13	integrate firearm safety education into appropriate subject
14	areas, if feasible, to ensure that every elementary grade
15	student completes the course of study in firearm safety
16	education.

18	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 180 days.
19	SECTION 1. THE ACT OF MARCH 10, 1949 (P.L.30, NO.14), KNOWN <
20	AS THE PUBLIC SCHOOL CODE OF 1949, IS AMENDED BY ADDING A
21	SECTION TO READ:
22	SECTION 1554. FIREARM SAFETY EDUCATION PROGRAM(A) TO
23	ASSIST SCHOOL ENTITIES THAT VOLUNTARILY ELECT TO PROVIDE FIREARM
24	SAFETY EDUCATION PROGRAMS FOR STUDENTS IN KINDERGARTEN THROUGH
25	GRADE EIGHT THE DEPARTMENT SHALL, IN CONSULTATION WITH ITS
26	OFFICE FOR SAFE SCHOOLS AND THE PENNSYLVANIA STATE POLICE,
27	DEVELOP CURRICULUM GUIDELINES FOR A STANDARDIZED PROGRAM OF
28	FIREARM SAFETY EDUCATION FOR THE STUDENTS IN KINDERGARTEN
29	THROUGH GRADE EIGHT TO PROMOTE THE PROTECTION AND SAFETY OF
30	CHILDREN ENROLLED IN PUBLIC SCHOOLS. THE CURRICULUM GUIDELINES

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1	SHALL INCORPORATE, AMONG OTHER PRINCIPLES OF FIREARM SAFETY,
2	ACCIDENT PREVENTION AND RULES UPON WHICH THE EDDIE EAGLE GUNSAFE
3	PROGRAM OFFERED BY THE NATIONAL RIFLE ASSOCIATION IS BASED.
4	(B) SCHOOL ENTITIES VOLUNTARILY ELECTING TO PROVIDE FIREARM
5	SAFETY EDUCATION SHALL OFFER INSTRUCTION PURSUANT TO THE
6	DEPARTMENT'S CURRICULUM GUIDELINES.
7	(C) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, THE FOLLOWING WORDS AND PHRASES
8	SHALL HAVE THE MEANINGS GIVEN TO THEM IN THIS SUBSECTION:
9	"DEPARTMENT." THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION OF THE
10	COMMONWEALTH.
11	"SCHOOL ENTITY." A SCHOOL DISTRICT, JOINT SCHOOL DISTRICT,
12	CHARTER SCHOOL, REGIONAL CHARTER SCHOOL, CYBER CHARTER SCHOOL,
13	INTERMEDIATE UNIT OR AREA VOCATIONAL-TECHNICAL SCHOOL.
14	SECTION 2. THIS ACT SHALL TAKE EFFECT IN 180 DAYS.

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
