2	(ii) The individual has a reasonable period of time,
3	not to exceed 60 days from the date of the imposition of
4	the disability, in which to sell or transfer the
5	individual's firearms to another eligible person who is
6	not a member of the prohibited person's household.
7	(iii) The individual's firearm rights may be
8	restored under section 6105(f)(1) (relating to persons
9	not to possess, use, manufacture, control, sell or
10	transfer firearms).
