AN ACT

- Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in trade and commerce, prohibiting the
- sale of certain laser pointers; and prescribing a penalty.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 8 § 7332. Sale of laser pointers.
- 9 <u>(a) Offense defined.--No person shall sell or offer to sell</u>
- 10 <u>a laser pointer.</u>
- 11 (b) Grading. -- A person who violates this section commits a
- 12 summary offense and, upon conviction thereof, shall be sentenced
- 13 to pay a fine in an amount not to exceed \$500 for a first
- 14 offense and not to exceed \$1,000 for a second or subsequent
- 15 offense.
- 16 (c) Nonapplicability.--This section shall not apply to a
- 17 <u>laser pointer that is:</u>
- 18 (1) affixed to a firearm, as defined in section 6102

- 1 (relating to definitions); or
- 2 (2) used by or under the supervision of a health care
- 3 practitioner licensed under the laws of this Commonwealth.
- 4 (d) Definition. -- For purposes of this section, a "laser
- 5 pointer" is a device that:
- 6 (1) emits laser light to project a beam that may be used
- for aiming, targeting or pointing out features of an object;
- 8 and
- 9 <u>(2) exceeds one milliwatt in output power.</u>
- 10 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
