- Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in firearms and other dangerous articles, further providing for firearms not to be carried without a license.

- 7 Section 1. Section 6106(a) and (b)(11) and (15) of Title 18
- 8 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended to read:
- 9 § 6106. Firearms not to be carried without a license.
- 10 (a) Offense defined.--

- (1) Except as provided in paragraph (2), any person who carries a firearm in any vehicle or any person who carries a firearm concealed on or about his person, except in his place of abode or fixed place of business, without a valid and lawfully issued license under this chapter commits a felony
- 17 (2) A person who is otherwise eligible to possess a

 18 valid license under this chapter but carries a firearm in any

 19 vehicle or any person who carries a firearm concealed on or

- about his person, except in his place of abode or fixed place
- of business, without a valid and lawfully issued license and
- 3 has not committed any other criminal violation commits a
- 4 misdemeanor of the [first] third degree.
- 5 (b) Exceptions. -- The provisions of subsection (a) shall not 6 apply to:
- 7 * * *
- 8 (11) Any [person while carrying a firearm in any
 9 vehicle, which person] nonresident who possesses a valid and
- 10 lawfully issued license [for that] to carry a concealed
- firearm for any purpose which has been issued under the laws
- of the United States or any other state, regardless of the
- 13 state of residence.

- 15 [(15) Any person who possesses a valid and lawfully
- issued license or permit to carry a firearm which has been
- issued under the laws of another state, regardless of whether
- 18 a reciprocity agreement exists between the Commonwealth and
- 19 the state under section 6109(k), provided:
- 20 (i) The state provides a reciprocal privilege for
- 21 individuals licensed to carry firearms under section
- 22 6109.
- 23 (ii) The Attorney General has determined that the
- firearm laws of the state are similar to the firearm laws
- of this Commonwealth.]

- 27 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
