AN ACT

Amending the act of June 30, 2012 (P.L. , No.9A), entitled "An 1 act to provide from the General Fund for the expenses of the 2 3 Executive and Judicial Departments, the State Government Support Agencies and the General Assembly of the 4 5 Commonwealth, the public debt and the public schools for the fiscal year July 1, 2012, to June 30, 2013, for certain 6 institutions and organizations, and for the payment of bills 7 incurred and remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal year 8 ending June 30, 2012; to provide appropriations from the 9 State Lottery Fund, the Tobacco Settlement Fund, the Aviation 10 Restricted Revenue Account, the Hazardous Material Response 11 Fund, The State Stores Fund, the Milk Marketing Fund, the Home Investment Trust Fund, the Emergency Medical Services 12 13 Operating Fund, the Tuition Payment Fund, the Banking 14 Department Fund, the Firearm Records Check Fund, the Ben 15 Franklin Technology Development Authority Fund, the Oil and 16 Gas Lease Fund, the Home Improvement Account and the 17 Cigarette Fire Safety and Firefighter Protection Act 18 19 Enforcement Fund, to the Executive Department; to provide appropriations from the Judicial Computer System Augmentation 20 Account to the Judicial Department for the fiscal year July 21 1, 2012, to June 30, 2013; to provide appropriations from the Motor License Fund for the fiscal year July 1, 2012, to June 22 23 30, 2013, for the proper operation of several departments of 24 25 the Commonwealth and the Pennsylvania State Police authorized 26 to spend Motor License Fund moneys; to provide for the 27 appropriation of Federal funds to the Executive Department of the Commonwealth and for the payment of bills remaining 28 unpaid at the close of the fiscal year ending June 30, 2012; 29

and to provide for the additional appropriation of Federal 1 and State funds from the General Fund for the Executive 2 Department of the Commonwealth for the fiscal year July 1, 2011, to June 30, 2012, and for the payment of bills incurred 3 4 and remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal year ending 5 6 June 30, 2012, and to provide appropriations from the Motor License Fund, the Home Improvement Account and the Cigarette 7 Fire Safety and Firefighter Protection Act Enforcement Fund for the fiscal year July 1, 2011, to June 30, 2012, and for the payment of bills incurred and remaining unpaid at the 8 9 10 close of the fiscal year ending June 30, 2012," further 11 providing for the appropriation to the Department of Public 12 Welfare. 13 14 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 15 hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. As much as relates to certain State 16 appropriations in section 220 of the act of June 30, 2012 (P.L. 17 , No.9A), known as the General Appropriation Act of 2012, are 18 19 amended to read: 20 Section 220.
