AN ACT

Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania 1 Consolidated Statutes, providing for the offense of 2 undetectable firearms. The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 4 hereby enacts as follows: 6 Section 1. Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a section to read: § 6143. Undetectable firearms. 8 9 (a) Offense defined. -- It shall be unlawful for a person to 10 manufacture, import, sell, ship, deliver, possess, transfer or 11 receive a firearm which meets any of the following: 12 (1) After removal of grips, stocks and magazines, is not 13 detectable by walk-through metal detectors. 14 (2) A major component of which, when subject to 15 inspection by the types of X-ray machines commonly used at airports, does not generate an image that accurately depicts 16

the shape of the component.

- 1 (b) Penalty. -- An offense under this section constitutes a
- 2 felony of the third degree.
- 3 (c) Definitions. -- As used in this section, the following
- 4 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
- 5 <u>subsection:</u>
- 6 "Major component." With respect to a firearm, any of the
- 7 <u>following:</u>
- 8 <u>(1) The barrel.</u>
- 9 <u>(2) The slide or cylinder.</u>
- 10 (3) The frame or receiver.
- 11 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
