- Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in firearms and other dangerous 2 articles, further providing for the offense of carrying 3 firearms on public streets or public property in 4 Philadelphia. 5 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 7 hereby enacts as follows: 8 Section 1. Section 6108 of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to read: 10 § 6108. Carrying firearms on public streets or public property 11 in Philadelphia. 12 (a) General rule. -- No person shall carry a firearm[, rifle or shotgun] at any time upon the public streets or upon any 13 public property in a city of the first class unless: 14 15 [such] the person is licensed to carry a firearm; or 16 [such] the person is exempt from licensing under 17 section 6106(b) of this title (relating to firearms not to be 18 carried without a license).

- 2 person in possession of a firearm at the time of arrest for a
- 3 violation of this section is not the lawful owner of the
- 4 <u>firearm, then the offense shall be graded as a felony of the</u>
- 5 third degree and, upon conviction, the person shall be
- 6 <u>sentenced to a minimum sentence of at least two years of</u>
- 7 <u>total confinement.</u>
- 8 (2) A person sentenced under this subsection shall not
- 9 <u>be eliqible for parole, probation, work release or furlough.</u>
- 10 (3) This subsection shall not apply to any person who is
- 11 <u>otherwise eliqible to possess a firearm under this chapter</u>
- 12 <u>and who is operating a motor vehicle which is registered in</u>
- the person's name or the name of a spouse or parent and which
- contains a firearm for which a valid license has been issued
- pursuant to section 6109 (relating to licenses) to the spouse
- or parent owning the firearm.
- 17 (c) Definition. -- For the purposes of this section, the term
- 18 "firearm" shall include any weapon which is designed to or may
- 19 readily be converted to expel any projectile by the action of an
- 20 explosive or the frame or receiver of the weapon.
- 21 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
