4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby enacts as follows:
6	Section 1. Section 2314 of Title 34 of the Pennsylvania
7	Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
8	§ 2314. Trespass on private property while hunting.
9	[(a) General ruleAny person who while violating any
10	provision of this title or any regulations promulgated under
11	this title and who in addition is found to be trespassing as
12	defined in 18 Pa.C.S. § 3503 (relating to criminal trespass)
13	shall be in violation of this section.
14	(b) PenaltyA violation of this section:
15	(1) A violation of this section is a summary offense of
16	the fifth degree.
17	(2) A second or subsequent violation of this section
18	within a seven-year period is a summary offense of the fifth

1 degree and may result in forfeiture of the privilege to hunt 2 or take game or wildlife anywhere within this Commonwealth 3 for a period of one year.] (a) General rule.--A person, while engaged in hunting or 4 furtaking, commits an offense if knowing that the person is not 5 licensed or privileged to do so the person: 6 7 (1) enters or remains on any land of another without authorization to do so, when the land is posted in a manner 8 9 prescribed by law or reasonably likely to come to the 10 person's attention or is fenced or enclosed in a manner manifestly designed to exclude trespassers; or 11 12 (2) enters or remains on any land of another without 13 authorization and defies an order not to enter or to leave 14 that has been personally communicated to the person by the 15 owner of the land or other authorized person. (b) Penalty.--An offense under this section shall be graded 16 17 as follows: 18 (1) A person who violates subsection (a) (1) commits a misdemeanor of the third degree and shall, upon conviction, 19 20 be sentenced to imprisonment for not more than one year and a 21 fine of not less than \$250. 22 (2) A person who violates subsection (a)(2) commits a 23 misdemeanor of the second degree and shall, upon conviction, 24 be sentenced to imprisonment for not more than two years and 25 a fine of not less than \$500 nor more than \$5,000. 26 (3) A second or subsequent violation of this section 27 within a seven-year period shall result in forfeiture of the privilege to hunt or take game or wildlife anywhere within 28 29 this Commonwealth for a period of one year. 30 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
