## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the
- Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in trial, providing for
- trial for certain criminal offenses involving firearms.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Title 42 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 8 § 9304. Trial for certain criminal offenses involving firearms.
- 9 (a) General rule. -- Whenever a person is charged with any
- 10 criminal offense who visibly possessed a firearm or a replica of
- 11 a firearm during the commission of the offense that would
- 12 <u>subject the person to sentencing under section 9712 (relating to</u>
- 13 <u>sentences</u> for offenses committed with firearms), the Attorney
- 14 General or the district attorney prosecuting the offense may not
- 15 enter any plea agreement or any other agreement with the person
- 16 charged that would exempt the person from the sentencing
- 17 mandated under section 9712.
- 18 (b) Trial by jury.--A person charged with a criminal offense
- 19 described under subsection (a) or the Attorney General or

- 1 <u>district attorney authorized to prosecute the criminal offense</u>
- 2 may not stipulate or authorize any trial for the criminal
- 3 prosecution other than trial by jury.
- 4 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
