5	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6	hereby enacts as follows:
7	Section 1. Section 6106.1 of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania
8	Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
9	§ 6106.1. Carrying loaded [weapons other than] firearms.
10	(a) General ruleExcept as provided in Title 34 (relating
11	to game), no person shall carry a loaded [pistol, revolver,
12	shotgun or rifle, other than a] firearm as defined in section
13	[6102 (relating to definitions)] <u>6105(i) (relating to persons</u>
14	not to possess, use, manufacture, control, sell or transfer
15	firearms), in any vehicle. The provisions of this section shall
16	not apply to persons excepted from the requirement of a license
17	to carry firearms under section 6106(b)(1), (2), (5) or (6)
18	(relating to firearms not to be carried without a license) nor

shall the provisions of this section be construed to permit
 persons to carry firearms in a vehicle where such conduct is
 prohibited by section 6106.

4 (b) Penalty.--A person who violates the provisions of this
5 section commits [a summary offense.]:

6 (1) A misdemeanor of the third degree for a first
7 offense.
8 (2) A misdemeanor of the first degree for a second or
9 subsequent offense.

10 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
