- Amending Titles 18 (Crimes and Offenses) and 53 (Municipalities) 1 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in firearms and 2 other dangerous articles, further providing for limitation on 3 the regulation of firearms and ammunition; and, in home rule and optional plan government, further providing for 5 limitation on municipal powers. 6 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 8 hereby enacts as follows: 9 Section 1. Section 6120(a) of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended and the section is amended by 10 adding a subsection to read: 11 12 § 6120. Limitation on the regulation of firearms and 13 ammunition. General rule. -- [No county, municipality or township] 14 Except as provided in subsection (a.4), no political subdivision 15 16 may in any manner regulate the lawful ownership, possession,
- 17 transfer or transportation of firearms, ammunition or ammunition
- 18 components when carried or transported for purposes not
- 19 prohibited by the laws of this Commonwealth.

- 2 (a.4) Exception. -- A political subdivision may, by ordinance,
- 3 regulate the possession, transfer or transportation of firearms,
- 4 <u>ammunition or ammunition components when carried or transported</u>
- 5 on any property owned, operated or maintained by the political
- 6 <u>subdivision including</u>, but not limited to:
- 7 <u>(1) Buildings.</u>
- 8 <u>(2)</u> Parks.
