- Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania 1 2 Consolidated Statutes, in inchoate crimes, providing for 3 disquised firearms. 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 6 Section 1. Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a section to read: § 908.2. Disquised firearms. 8 9 (a) Offense defined. -- A person commits a misdemeanor of the 10 first degree if the person makes repairs, sells or otherwise 11 deals in, uses or possesses: 12 (1) a disquised firearm. 13 (2) a firearm that is not detectable as a weapon or 14 potential weapon by an x-ray machine commonly used at 15 airports or a walk-through metal detector. 16 (b) Definition. -- As used in this section, the term
- 18 shape or configuration such that it does not resemble a handgun,

"disquised firearm" means a firearm that is constructed in a

- 1 rifle, shotgun or machine gun, including a firearm that
- 2 <u>resembles a key chain, pen, cigarette lighter, cigarette</u>
- 3 package, cellphone, smart phone, wallet or cane.
- 4 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
