6	Section 1. Section 2706 of Title 34 of the Pennsylvania
7	Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subsection to read:
8	§ 2706. Resident license and fee exemptions.

10	(i) College studentsA college student who attends a
11	college or university located within this Commonwealth shall be
12	eligible for a resident hunting license if the college student:
13	(1) Has applied to an issuing agent or the commission.
14	(2) Provides a valid college identification card as
15	proof of enrollment.
16	(3) Pays the issuing agent or the commission a license
17	fee and issuing agent fee as provided in section 2709
18	(relating to license costs and fees).

1 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
