Certain bullets prohibited. 10 11 (a) Offense defined .-- It is unlawful for any person to possess, sell, transfer, use or attempt to use a KTW teflon-12 13 coated bullet or other armor-piercing ammunition [while 14 committing or attempting to commit a crime of violence as 15 defined in section 6102 (relating to definitions)]. 16

offering or exposing for sale, use, purchase or possession of armor-piercing ammunition by a person who is a government officer, agent or employee, a member of the armed forces of the United States or the National Guard or a peace officer, to the extent that the individual is authorized by the government to sell, offer or expose for sale, use, purchase, possess or control armor-piercing ammunition and, consistent with the authorization, does so while acting within the scope of the person's duties.

- (3) The following shall be exempt from the prohibition under subsection (a):
- (i) The possession and control of armor-piercing

 ammunition by a person who finds armor-piercing

 ammunition, if the person is not prohibited from

 possessing firearms or ammunition under Federal or State

 law, and the person possesses or controls the armor
 piercing ammunition no longer than is necessary to

 deliver or transport the same to a law enforcement agency

 for the agency's disposition.
 - (ii) Any person or the person's representative or agent who is legally engaged in the business of manufacturing, repairing or dealing in armor-piercing ammunition.
