AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, in firearms and other dangerous
- articles, further providing for locking device for firearms.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 6142(a) and (f) of Title 18 of the
- 7 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended to read:
- 8 § 6142. Locking device for firearms.
- 9 (a) Offense defined. -- It shall be unlawful for any licensee
- 10 to sell, deliver or transfer any firearm [as defined in section
- 11 6102 (relating to definitions)], other than an antique firearm
- 12 as defined in section 6118 (relating to antique firearms), to
- 13 any other person, other than another licensee, unless the
- 14 transferee is provided with or purchases a locking device for
- 15 that firearm or the design of the firearm incorporates a locking
- 16 device.

- 1 (f) Definitions.--As used in this section, the following
- 2 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
- 3 subsection:
- 4 <u>"Firearm." Either of the following:</u>
- 5 (1) a weapon that is designed to or readily convertible
- 6 to expel a projectile by the action of an explosive; or
- 7 (2) the frame or receiver of a weapon.
- 8 "Licensee." Any licensed manufacturer, importer or dealer of
- 9 firearms.
- 10 "Locking device." Either of the following:
- 11 (1) a device that, when installed on a firearm, is
- designed to prevent the firearm from being operated without
- 13 first deactivating the device; or
- 14 (2) a device that is incorporated into the design of a
- firearm and that is designed to prevent the operation of the
- firearm by anyone not having access to the device.
- 17 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
