AN ACT

- Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
- Consolidated Statutes, in firearms and other dangerous articles, further providing for sale or transfer of firearms. 3
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- Section 1. Section 6111(b)(1), (1.1)(i) and (6) and (f)(2)6
- of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are
- amended and the section is amended by adding a subsection to
- 9 read:
- § 6111. Sale or transfer of firearms. 10
- 11
- 12 (b) Duty of seller. -- No licensed importer, licensed
- 13 manufacturer or licensed dealer shall sell or deliver any
- 14 firearm to another person, other than a licensed importer,
- licensed manufacturer, licensed dealer or licensed collector, 15
- until the conditions of subsection (a) have been satisfied and 16

1 until he has:

[For purposes of a firearm as defined in section 2 6102 (relating to definitions), obtained a completed 3 application/record of sale from the potential buyer or 4 5 transferee to be filled out in triplicate, the original copy to be sent to the Pennsylvania State Police, postmarked via 6 7 first class mail, within 14 days of the sale, one copy to be retained by the licensed importer, licensed manufacturer or 8 9 licensed dealer for a period of 20 years and one copy to be 10 provided to the purchaser or transferee. The form of this application/record of sale shall be no more than one page in 11 12 length and shall be promulgated by the Pennsylvania State 13 Police and provided by the licensed importer, licensed 14 manufacturer or licensed dealer. The application/record of sale shall include the name, address, birthdate, gender, 15 16 race, physical description and Social Security number of the 17 purchaser or transferee, the date of the application and the 18 caliber, length of barrel, make, model and manufacturer's 19 number of the firearm to be purchased or transferred. The 20 application/record of sale shall also contain the following 21 question: 22 Are you the actual buyer of the firearm(s), as defined 23 under 18 Pa.C.S. § 6102 (relating to definitions), listed 24 on this application/record of sale? Warning: You are not 25 the actual buyer if you are acquiring the firearm(s) on behalf of another person, unless you are legitimately 26 27 acquiring the firearm as a gift for any of the following individuals who are legally eligible to own a firearm: 28 29 (1) spouse; 30 (2) parent;

1	(3) child;
2	(4) grandparent; or
3	(5) grandchild.] For purposes of a firearm as
4	defined in section 6102 (relating to definitions),
5	obtained a completed application/record of sale from the
6	potential buyer or transferee:
7	(i) A licensed importer, licensed manufacturer or
8	licensed dealer exempted under subsection (k) may
9	complete an application/record of sale in paper format
10	which shall be filled out in triplicate, with the
11	original copy to be sent to the Pennsylvania State
12	Police, postmarked via first class mail, within 14 days
13	of the sale.
14	(ii) A licensed importer, licensed manufacturer or
15	licensed dealer not exempted under subsection (k) shall
16	complete an electronic application/record of sale at the
17	time of transfer. A licensed importer, licensed
18	manufacturer or licensed dealer exempted under subsection
19	(k) who chooses not to complete an application/record of
20	sale in paper format shall complete an electronic
21	application/record of sale at the time of transfer. A
22	completed electronic application/record of sale shall be
23	transmitted to the Pennsylvania State Police.
24	(iii) A copy of the application/record of sale shall
25	be retained either in electronic or paper format by the
26	licensed importer, licensed manufacturer or licensed
27	dealer for a period of 20 years and a copy shall be
28	provided to the purchaser or transferee in electronic or
29	paper format.
30	(iv) The application/record of sale shall be no more

1	than one page in length and shall be promulgated by the
2	Pennsylvania State Police and provided by the licensed
3	importer, licensed manufacturer or licensed dealer. The
4	application/record of sale shall include the name,
5	address, birth date, gender, race, physical description
6	and Social Security number of the purchaser or
7	transferee, the date of the application and the caliber,
8	length of barrel, make, model and manufacturer's number
9	of the firearm to be purchased or transferred. The
10	application/record of sale shall also contain the
11	<pre>following question:</pre>
12	Are you the actual buyer of the firearm(s), as
13	defined under 18 Pa.C.S. § 6102 (relating to
14	definitions), listed on this application/record
15	of sale? Warning: You are not the actual buyer if
16	you are acquiring the firearm(s) on behalf of
17	another person, unless you are legitimately
18	acquiring the firearm as a gift for any of the
19	following individuals who are legally eligible to
20	<pre>own a firearm:</pre>
21	(1) spouse;
22	(2) parent;
23	<u>(3) child;</u>
24	(4) grandparent; or
25	(5) grandchild.
26	(v) In the event of an electronic failure under
27	section 6111.1(b)(2) (relating to Pennsylvania State
28	Police) that affects the electronic application/record of
29	sale and upon notice from the Pennsylvania State Police,
30	a licensed importer, licensed manufacturer or licensed

1 dealer shall proceed as if exempted under subsection (k) and shall obtain a completed application/record of sale, 2 in paper format, from the potential buyer or transferee. 3 A licensed importer, <u>licensed manufacturer or licensed</u> 4 dealer shall proceed with the application/record of sale 5 as prescribed in subparagraphs (i) and (iii) until 6 7 notified by the Pennsylvania State Police that the 8 electronic failure no longer remains.

- (1.1) On the date of publication in the Pennsylvania Bulletin of a notice by the Pennsylvania State Police that the instantaneous records check has been implemented, all of the following shall apply:
- In the event of an electronic failure under 13 (i) 14 section 6111.1(b)(2) [(relating to Pennsylvania State Police)] for purposes of a firearm which exceeds the 15 16 barrel and related lengths set forth in section 6102, 17 [obtained] a licensed importer, licensed manufacturer or 18 licensed dealer shall obtain a completed 19 application/record of sale in paper form from the 20 potential buyer or transferee to be filled out in 21 triplicate, the original copy to be sent to the 22 Pennsylvania State Police, postmarked via first class 23 mail, within 14 days of sale, one copy to be retained by 24 the licensed importer, licensed manufacturer or licensed 25 dealer for a period of 20 years and one copy to be 26 provided to the purchaser or transferee.

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(6) Unless it has been discovered pursuant to a criminal history, juvenile delinquency and mental health records background check that the potential purchaser or transferee

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- is prohibited from possessing a firearm pursuant to section
- 2 6105, no information received [via telephone following the
- implementation of] by the instantaneous background check
- 4 system from a purchaser or transferee who has received a
- 5 unique approval number shall be retained by the Pennsylvania
- 6 State Police.

- 8 (f) Application of section. --
- 9 * * *
- 10 (2) The provisions contained in subsections (a) [and],
- 11 (c) and (k) shall only apply to pistols or revolvers with a
- barrel length of less than 15 inches, any shotgun with a
- barrel length of less than 18 inches, any rifle with a barrel
- 14 length of less than 16 inches or any firearm with an overall
- 15 length of less than 26 inches.

- 17 (k) Electronic reporting exemption. -- A licensed importer,
- 18 licensed manufacturer or licensed dealer who conducts 20 or
- 19 fewer firearm sales and transfers per year shall not be required
- 20 to use an electronic application/record of sale. The following
- 21 shall apply:
- 22 (1) The Pennsylvania State Police shall conduct an
- annual review of the transactions of each licensed importer,
- licensed manufacturer and licensed dealer over the past
- 25 calendar year to determine whether the licensed importer,
- licensed manufacturer or licensed dealer is exempted from the
- 27 use of an electronic application/record of sale. The
- Pennsylvania State Police shall notify each licensed
- 29 importer, licensed manufacturer and licensed dealer of an
- 30 exemption to the use of an electronic application/record of

- 1 <u>sale no later than April 1 of each year.</u>
- 2 (2) Nothing in this section shall be construed to
- 3 prohibit a licensed importer, licensed manufacturer or
- 4 <u>licensed dealer from choosing to use an electronic</u>
- 5 <u>application/record of sale.</u>
- 6 Section 2. This act shall take effect April 1, 2025.
