A BILL

To nullify any generalized, routine or ongoing reporting requirement imposed on a person licensed under section 923 of title 18, United States Code, that is based on the geographic location in which the licensee is located or on the sale of multiple rifles or shotguns, or any specific type of rifle or shotgun, to the same person.

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Protecting the Second
5 Amendment Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. NULLIFICATION OF ANY GENERALIZED, ROUTINE**
2 **OR ONGOING REPORTING REQUIREMENT IM-**
3 **POSED ON A PERSON LICENSED UNDER SEC-**
4 **TION 923 OF TITLE 18, UNITED STATES CODE,**
5 **THAT IS BASED ON THE GEOGRAPHIC LOCA-**
6 **TION IN WHICH THE LICENSEE IS LOCATED**
7 **OR ON THE SALE OF MULTIPLE RIFLES OR**
8 **SHOTGUNS, OR ANY SPECIFIC TYPE OF RIFLE**
9 **OR SHOTGUN, TO THE SAME PERSON.**

10 No person licensed under section 923 of title 18,
11 United States Code, shall be subject to any generalized,
12 routine or ongoing reporting requirement based on the ge-
13 ographic location in which the licensee is located or on
14 the sale of multiple rifles or shotguns, or any specific type
15 of rifle or shotgun, to the same person.
