Mr. PAUL introduced the following joint resolution; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Foreign Relations

JOINT RESOLUTION

Providing for congressional disapproval of the proposed foreign military sale to the Government of Egypt of certain defense articles and services.

1 *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*
2 *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the following proposed foreign military sale to the
4 Government of Egypt is prohibited:

5 (1) The sale of the following defense articles
6 and services, described in Transmittal No. 22–11,
7 submitted to Congress pursuant to section 36(b)(1)
8 of the Arms Export Control Act (22 U.S.C.
9 2776(b)(1)), and published in the Congressional
10 Record on May 26, 2022:

1 (A) The following Major Defense Equip-
2 ment (MDE): Twenty-three (23) CH-47F Chi-
3 nook Helicopters. Fifty-six (56) T-55-GA-
4 714A Engines (46 installed, 10 spares). Fifty-
5 two (52) Embedded Global Positioning System
6 (GPS) Inertial Navigation Systems (INS)
7 (EGI) (46 installed, 6 spares). Twenty-nine
8 (29) AN/AAR-57 Common Missile Warning
9 Systems (CMWS) (23 installed, 6 spares). Sev-
10 enty-five (75) M-240 Machine Guns (69 in-
11 stalled, 6 spares).

12 (B) The following non-MDE: Common
13 Missile Warning System (CMWS) classified
14 software; AN/APR-39 Radar Warning Receiv-
15 ers (RWR); AN/AVR-2B Laser Detecting Sets
16 (LDS); High Frequency (HF) radios; Aircraft
17 Survivability Equipment (ASE) (including
18 25.4mm decoy cartridges, impulse cartridges
19 for cable cutters and aircraft cartridges); AN/
20 ARN-147 Very High Frequency (VHF) Omni
21 Directional Radio Range/Instrument Landing
22 System (VOR/ILS) receivers; AN/ARN-153
23 Tactical Airborne Navigation System (TACAN)
24 radios; AN/APN-209 radar altimeters; AN/
25 AVS-6 Night Vision Devices (NVD); 7.62mm

1 ammunition; items and services to support the
2 mission equipment; hardware and services re-
3 quired to implement additional aircraft options
4 such as: rescue hoists; external cargo slings and
5 nets; Bambi fire buckets; Fast Rope Insertion
6 Extraction Systems (FRIES); Cargo On/Off
7 Loading Systems (COOLS); Extended Range
8 Fuel Systems (ERFS); upgrade to the mainte-
9 nance hangar and additional parking pads; spe-
10 cial tools and test equipment; ground support
11 equipment; airframe and engine spare parts;
12 technical data; publications; Maintenance Work
13 Orders/Engineering Change Proposals (MWO/
14 ECPs); technical assistance; transportation;
15 training; and other related elements of logistics
16 and program support.
